Mariam took an intensive, two-week course in Writing the Future at Columbia University's Pre-College Programs. This course explored the enduring appeal of dystopian and science fiction narratives, investigating why these stories continue to captivate audiences. It analyzed how writers use these genres to speculate on future possibilities and critique contemporary society. Assigned texts ranged from classics like "1984" to recent global contributions, spanning novels, short stories, films, and podcasts. Themes included ethics in artificial intelligence, technological advancement, and the intersection of history with science fiction. Discussions also examined the future direction of the genre and its broad audience appeal. Students honed their writing skills through essays and responses, practiced rhetorical analysis, and engaged in collaborative discussions to enhance their understanding of course materials and refine their communication skills. By course end, students had developed as writers, critical thinkers, and effective communicators.

Mariam was a pleasure to have in this course this summer. She was consistently engaged in our course material. Throughout the class, she was always positive, respectful, and kind. She worked well with her classmates and seemed genuinely invested in learning as much as she could during her time in the program.

Mariam successfully completed all of her assignments for the course. Her textual analysis explored the role of fear and propaganda in Orwell's 1984. This essay demonstrated Mariam's complex understanding of the novel and made some strong points about the connection between language and thought. She also effectively revised and expanded the essay to include outside research. Her next assignment, a discussion leader presentation, was clear, engaging, and centered on observant discussion questions. For her creative assignment, Mariam developed a poem describing a dystopian society and its impact on a central speaker. The piece was nicely grounded in common themes from the dystopian genre and included strong description. I hope that Mariam moves forward with this idea and continues to revise and develop her poetry.

Overall, it is clear that Mariam has a command of many of the fundamentals of strong academic and creative writing. She is a talented writer and an intellectually-curious student. I was pleased with her work in the course and have no doubt that she will prove an exemplary college student in the coming years.
